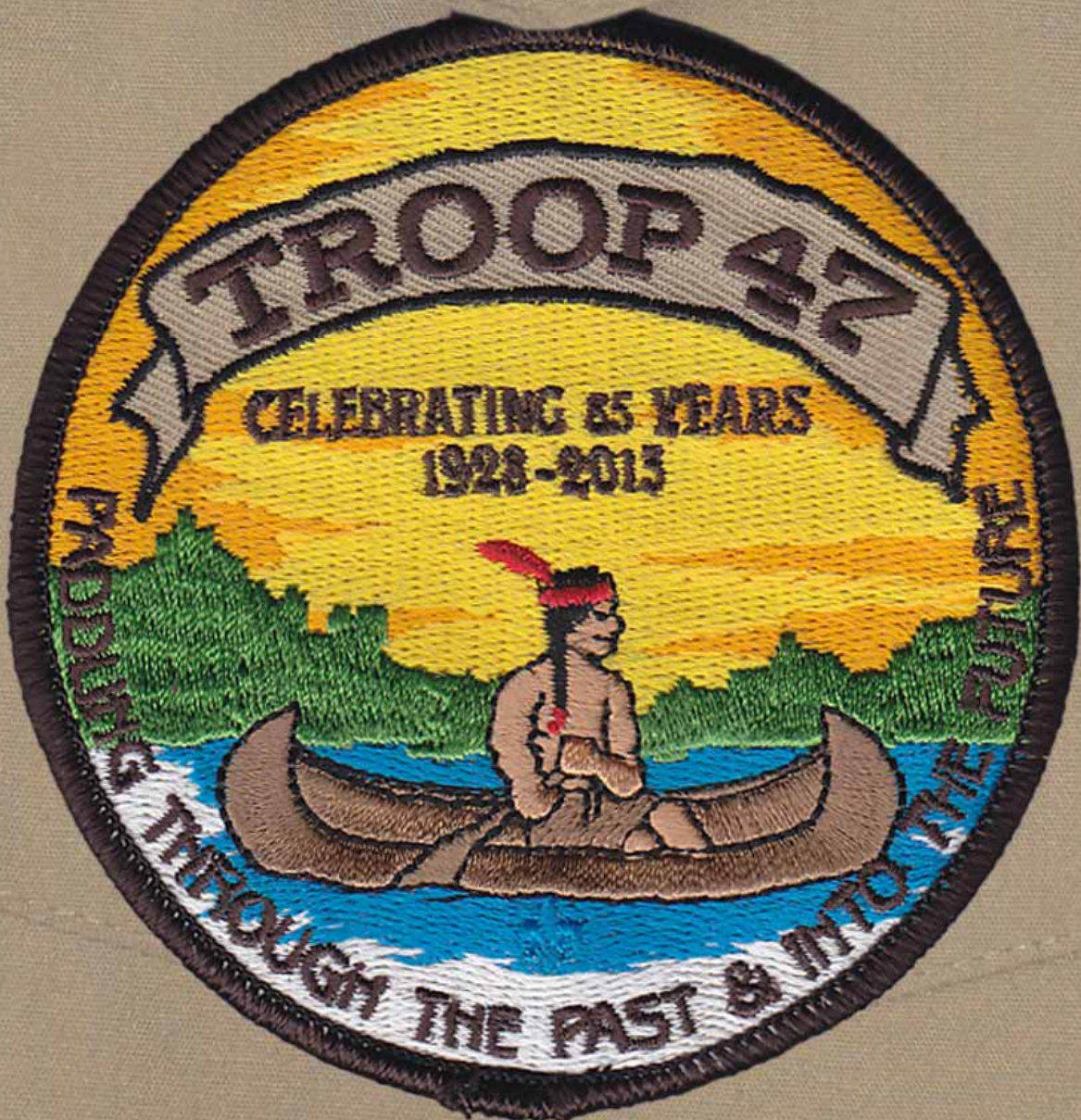

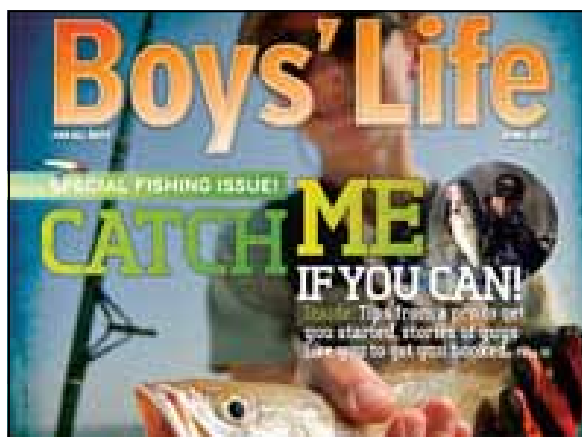


Dear Seth:

Dear Mr. Peden:

For 85 years, Troop 47 has used the Scout motto "Be Prepared" to usher young men into manhood. This same motto has played a significant role in my life's journey and any successes that I might have in the future.

I recently received a letter from you containing a resume I prepared when I was a 13-year-old freshman at Fairhope High School, with my eyes on the rank of Eagle Scout. That same year, in 1993, I discovered a poem that captures the meaning of the Scout motto – "If" by Rudyard Kipling, a friend of Lord Baden-Powell, the founder of scouting.

The opening lines of Kipling's poem reads: *"If you can keep your head when all about you / Are losing theirs and blaming it on you; / If you can trust yourself when all men doubt you, / But make allowance for their doubting too."* It was through scouting that I learned this poem is about leadership and service.

And so, in 1993, I served as Senior Patrol Leader for the Mobile Area Council delegation to the National Scout Jamboree. As part of that trip, we traveled to Washington, DC, toured the Nation's capitol, and visited with members of the U.S. Congress from Alabama. I was hooked.

Experiencing the majesty of our capitol city inspired me to work as a legislative aide in Congress after college. I later attended Howard University School of Law, and I currently work as a corporate attorney. However, I still have a passion to serve my community. The fruit of a seed that was planted by the citizenship merit badges I earned on the trail to Eagle Scout.

Lord Baden-Powell summarized the principles of scouting in his final letter to all Scouts as follows:

"Happiness does not come from being rich, nor merely being successful in your career, nor by self-indulgence. One step towards happiness is to make yourself healthy and strong while you are a boy, so that you can be useful and so you can enjoy life when you are a man... But the real way to get happiness is by giving out happiness to other people. Try and leave this world a little better than you found it and when your turn comes to die, you can die happy in feeling that at any rate you have not wasted your time but have done your best. 'Be Prepared' in this way, to live happy and to die happy — stick to your Scout Promise always — even after you have ceased to be a boy — and God help you to do it."

When people see my resume today, they often ask why "BSA, Eagle Scout" is prominently featured. My response is that I continue to use the lessons I learned as a Scout each day. Whether representing a company, exercising my rights as a citizen, or being a faithful father and husband, my actions are guided by the Scout Oath, Law, and Motto.

I am thankful that scouting provided the foundation upon which I have tried to build a happy life, according to the principles described by Baden-Powell and Kipling. And I am reminded of my duty by a small plaque on my desk on which are inscribed two words: Be Prepared.

What Scouting Has Done For Me

The impact of Scouting in my life overall is almost more than I can measure. As I grew up, the influence that Scouts had on my development as a member of society and a person, became more and more evident as I began making more important life choices. The Scout Oath and Scout Law began to influence even the small decisions. They helped me to become a person that people looked up to and trusted and relied upon. As it came time to choose a career one choice became more and more apparent; enlisting in the United States Army. After enlisting in the Army, Basic Training was next. Because of my Scout training I was able to successfully complete the rigorous training, as well as the skill, mental and physical tests on the way to becoming a soldier. I was able to use the Scout Skills taught to me all those years of Scouting from my first year as a Cub Scout all the way to Eagle. My instructors taught me the seven core Army values, as I learned them I realized that is was actually a modified version of the Scout Law. The two sets of values were a perfect match and guided me through Basic Training. I had been ready for this for years. What is really important to remember here is that every Scout no matter if he is a Tenderfoot just starting out or a Life Scout so close to Eagle he can taste it; I say this: The Scout Oath and Scout Law should be your constant guide. By following these guides any career you choose will be a perfect fit, because the guides of Scouting are not just the guides of a soldier but of a business man, an actor, a doctor, a lawyer or even a president. So my fellow Scouts and Scouters remember that the Scout Oath and Law are the mold for the kind of citizen and human being everyone looks to as a role model.

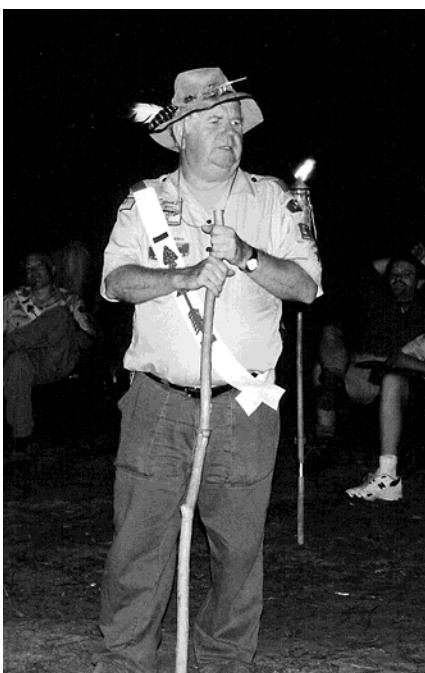

Scoutmaster Seth Peden

Seth Peden, also known as “Capt’n”, was born and raised in Mobile. He began his youth Scouting career in 1951 as a Cub Scout and progressed into Boy Scouting where he achieved First Class Rank. After graduating Murphy High School, Seth attended Perkinston College in Mississippi and then transferred to the University of Alabama branch in Mobile.



Ever since he was a child, Seth had the ambition of becoming a fireman. He realized his calling and served his community as a Fire Captain on the Mobile Fire & Rescue Department. Firefighting and rescue operations were a part of his career for 27 years before his retirement in 1995. During his service as Captain he was the Incident Commander of the Amtrak train accident during which oversaw all operations on the scene.

Fairhope became the new home for Seth and his family after he moved across the bay to Point Clear in 1980. Seth became drawn into Scouting as an adult leader after his son Jeffrey came home from a Cub Scout roundup and said, “Daddy, I want to be a Cub Scout.” This marked the beginning of a lifetime of scout leadership for Seth. Before becoming our Scoutmaster in 1993, Seth held numerous other troop and pack positions. These included Assistant Scoutmaster, Assistant Packmaster, Webelos Den Leader, and Den Leader. Seth has produced one of the largest troops in the Mobile Area Council; however, he insists, “No three or four people make the troop function. The troop needs many dedicated adult leaders to produce the program for the youth,” Seth explains. Over 50 young men have achieved the rank of Eagle

Scout since Seth became Scoutmaster, including his son Jeffrey in 1995. He encourages parents to get involved in every opportunity with their sons in Scouting.

Seth has been recognized for all of his accomplishments in Boy Scouts with many diverse awards reflecting his commitment and desire. Some awards include the Webelo Leaders Training Award, Den Leaders Training Award, Boy Scout Leaders Training Award, 20 Year Veteran Award, Wood Badge Training, the District Award of Merit, and the Scoutmaster's Key. In 1993, Scouting's National Honor Society Woa Cholena Lodge bestowed the Vigil Honor upon Seth for his outstanding service to his troop, camp, and council. He is also a Founders Award Recipient, one of only 15 in our lodge. Then, in 1998, the council presented Seth with the Silver Beaver Award, the highest award a council can give for service and devotion. Seth was the 2006 recipient of the Rotary Club Volunteer of the Year Award for his service to the troop and community. He was Scoutmaster for the 2010 contingent to the National Scout Jamboree in Fort A.P Hill, Virginia, the 100th anniversary of Scouting.

Scouting is a family affair, and very much so for Seth. Sadly, 11 years ago his wife, Mrs. Ruth Ann, passed away. She was always there for and fully supportive of the troop. She was a blessing to the troop and to everyone who knew her. But Seth moves on to nurture his boys and leaders. “Remember, one eye is always lookin’...”

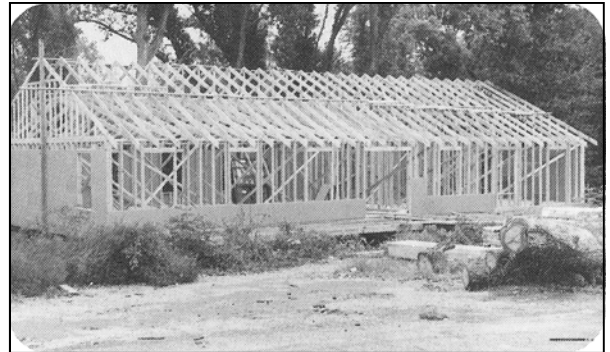
The Building of the Louis E. Dantzler Memorial Scout Lodge

In the mid 1970's, Troop 47 flourished under the leadership of Louis Dantzler. However, Mr. Dantzler became ill and was forced to leave active Scouting. The troop had been using a dilapidated, one room building for their meeting place, but this was demolished to make way for the parking lot behind Fairhope United Methodist Church.

In 1978 Troop 47 membership dwindled to eight members, and the troop was without a permanent scoutmaster. During that summer two Eagle Scouts, Mitch Dantzler and David Hermez, both students at Auburn University, served as Co-Scoutmasters to keep the troop going. The church fellowship hall was used as a meeting place.

After Mr. Dantzler's death in 1979, Mrs. Dantzler approached Rev. Calhoun, pastor of the Fairhope United Methodist Church, with a plan to donate funds to build a permanent Scout Hut. The initial donation was \$5000 with an equal amount to be donated after construction was underway.



In February 1980, the Louis E. Dantzler Memorial Scout Lodge Committee was initially formed comprised of nine men, all members of Fairhope United Methodist Church: Roy Butgereit, Candler Cain, Jack Mayhall, David Myrick, John Parker, Paul Perfect, Wayne Smith, Fred Watkins, Sr., and Fred Watkins, Jr. Later additions to the Committee included Clarence Bishop, Butch Harding, Richard Keenan, Reggie Palmer, Alan Perfect and Charles Wiggins.

Initial work involved looking for a building site as this was required before design of the facility could be completed. The site finally selected was donated to the Church by Mr. Kenneth Cain. Although this was a desirable location due to the

proximity to the Church, it was a poor location as far as a building site as a special piling design was required to support the facility. The City of Fairhope had concerns with this location due to the area being a high drainage area, both above and below ground. The City was very supportive of our efforts and later gave their approval.

Architect Dale Brigham volunteered his services and prepared working drawings based on the piling design and the sketches provided by the Committee. Piling work was completed in December 1980 and floor beams were in place by June 1981. Floor joists and decking started in September 1981 and the building trusses erected in October 1981. The building was dried in by the end of the year.

With this amount of building completed, Mrs. Dantzler transmitted the second \$5000 donation in October 1981.

The electrical work was completed by Mr. Curtis George in 1982 and drywall work started in the service areas. Drywall work and the sprinkler system were completed in 1983. The troop began using the facility prior to the building being completed and at this time had 23 members. Paneling of the main meeting room was completed in 1984.



The dedication ceremony, attended by Mrs. Louis Dantzler and Eagle Scout son Mitch, and daughter Dianne Strong, was held in the completed facility on October 21, 1984.

With this facility and dedicated Scoutmasters and assistants, Troop 47 has prospered and currently over 75 boys are learning the value of Scouting.

Starting with the Dantzler donation, this whole project was a labor of love. There were many, many companies and individuals that donated money, materials, equipment and furnishings and long hours of labor to complete

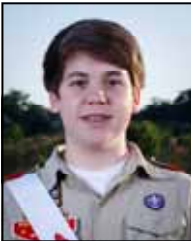


Christopher Biggs is a Scout in the Stag Patrol. He is famous for making balloon animals at Camporee.
